1. All entries must be at the Arts & Crafts Building between 12:00 noon - 5:00 pm, Saturday, July 31st.
2. Entry tags must be attached to exhibit BEFORE delivery to the Arts & Crafts Building. Place entry tag on corner of right side of material.
3. Each article shown must be the work of the exhibitor.
4. Entries limited to two entries per exhibitor per category.
5. Any item designed to be hung must be equipped with a wire hanger.
6. NO SOILED, WORN OR UNFINISHED ARTICLE, OR ANY ARTICLE THAT HAS BEEN SHOWN MORE THAN ONE TIME PREVIOUSLY WILL BE CONSIDERED.
7. New work is given preference, and no article considered unworthy by the judge (whose decision is final) will be given a premium.
8. A PROFESSIONAL is a person following an occupation as a means of livelihood or for gain. This department is NOT for professionals.
9. The Fair will use reasonable care, but will, under NO circumstances, be responsible for any loss or breakage which occurs.

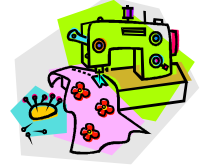

PURPLE HEARTS FOR VETERANS

The Fair Board and the Arts and Crafts Department of the Columbiana County Fair open our hearts to ALL veterans. We believe that they all deserve a “Purple Heart” for their service to our country. In that regard, we have instituted a new class that will be open for quilts, afghans, cross stitch blankets and throws, as well as blanket-type items for both the Senior and Junior Divisions.

These items will not be returned to the exhibitor after the Fair, but rather will be distributed to Veterans in Columbiana County, and V.A. hospitals and nursing facilities state and nation-wide. Preference will be given to wounded veterans returning from Afghanistan, Iraq and Iran, but will also be given to veterans from all conflicts.

Items must be at least lap size (40” x 60”), but no larger than a twin size, be Red, White & Blue in color, and include at least one purple heart, either appliquéd or incorporated as part of the entire design, on the item. A signed waiver form must be signed by the exhibitor, (found on the reverse side of the entry form blank).

A service of dedication, with members of the VFW present, will be held on Sunday, August 8 in front of the Grandstand at 11:30 a.m., where local Veterans from all conflicts will be presented with the top winning projects, as well as the Fair Board’s contributions.

It is our hope to include a 21-gun salute in this ceremony. Our Veterans, the Fair Board, and the Arts & Crafts Department thank you for your generosity and willingness to participate in this new class.

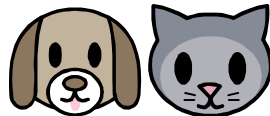
