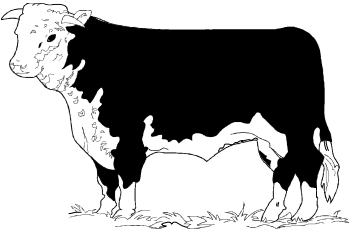

ENTRIES CLOSE: Friday, July 15, 2011  
ENTRY FEES: \$2.50 per entry, per class

- 1. All beef cattle entered in this department, must be stabled on the fairgrounds and be in place by 8:00 pm, Monday, August 1, 2011, and remain there until 8:00 pm the last night of the fair.
2. The Board reserves the right to reject all entries after all stalls have been filled.
3. No exhibitor shall make more than two entries in any one class.
4. The date of computing ages of beef breeds of cattle is fixed as Sept. 1, except as stated in premium lists. Registration papers must be available for checking prior to show.
5. No change can be made in any class after filing or from those stated below.
6. All animals entered in this department, except calves less than one year, must be registered, and exhibitors must furnish registration certificates that will be checked by the superintendent in charge. The judge will not consider, or pass upon, any which have not been registered.
7. All beef cattle to be shown must comply with the Health Requirements as stated in the Exhibitor Rules on the following pages of this book.
8. All possessions must be removed at the end of the fair or the exhibitor will be fined if anything is hauled away.
9. Any mulch used will be provided by the Fairboard only, at \$12.00 per yard. No exceptions.
