(plus \$1.00 per household to cover entry tag mailing expense)
ENTRY DAY: Saturday, July 30th - 12:00 Noon - 6:00 pm
JUDGING: Sunday, July 31st at 11:00 am

- 1. All entries must be at the Arts & Crafts Building between 12:00 noon - 5:00 pm, Saturday, July 30th.
- 2. Entry tags must be attached to exhibit BEFORE delivery to the Arts & Crafts Building. Place entry tag on corner of right side of material.
- 3. Each article shown must be the work of the exhibitor.
- 4. Entries limited to three entries per exhibitor per category.
- 5. Any item designed to be hung must be equipped with a wire hanger. No sawtooth hangers.
- 6. NO SOILED, WORN OR UNFINISHED ARTICLE, OR ANY ARTICLE THAT HAS BEEN SHOWN MORE THAN ONE TIME PREVIOUSLY WILL BE CONSIDERED.
- 7. New work is given preference, and no article considered unworthy by the judge (whose decision is final) will be given a premium.
- 8. A PROFESSIONAL is a person following an occupation as a means of livelihood or for gain. This department is NOT for professionals.
- 9. The Fair will use reasonable care, but will, under NO circumstances, be responsible for any loss or breakage which occurs.

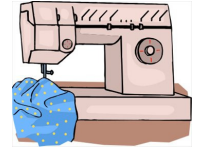

“THE PRICE OF FREEDOM”



In keeping with the Patriotic theme established in 2010 for the Arts & Crafts Department of the Columbiana County Fair along with the success of the Purple Hearts for Veterans project, Director Sharen Cope has announced the category title for the 2011 Fair in the quilting, knitting, crocheting, and cross stitch classes.

Requirements for exhibitors’ submissions remain the same as 2010. Items submitted should be at least 40” x 60” (lap robe size), but not larger than twin, and **MUST** be red, white & blue in color.

Cope stresses the fact that exhibitors will be required to sign a Waiver Form indicating they are aware their items will not be returned to them and they receive no compensation for their entry.

Cope is working with some of the veterans organizations in Columbiana County to make arrangements for the quilts & afghans/blankets to be distributed to current and past veterans from the County.

All entries will be judged and displayed in the Arts & Crafts Building as they normally would, however, at the conclusion of the Fair, Cope will work with these veterans organizations to be certain that entered items are delivered to those veterans whose names have been submitted.

Families wanting their veteran to receive one of these items should send the necessary information for their veteran and a contact number to the Fair Office, P.O. Box 356, Lisbon, Ohio 44432 to the attention of Sharen Cope; or to VFW Post 892, 496 Arch Street, Salem, Oh. 44460 to the attention of Blair Whitman; or to AmVets Post 45, 750 S. Broadway, Salem, Ohio 44460 attention Butch Hardy. Any other veterans organizations who would like to participate are asked to contact Cope at the Fair office address.
